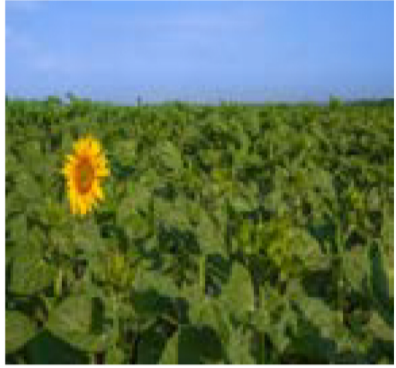
Two Dead After Ceiling Grill Falls at Galaxy Blue Sapphire Mall in Greater Noida



Two men died after an iron ceiling grill fell on them at Greater Noida's Galaxy Blue Sapphire Mall on Sunday. The victims died on the spot after being struck by the falling ceiling grill which fell from the fifth floor. The incident took place when they were moving towards the escalator. ADCP Central Hridesh Katheria said that the victims, aged around 35, belonged to Vijaynagar, Ghaziabad, and were walking towards the escalator when the accident happened. He added that the ceiling was there for fencing which suddenly fell from the fifth floor. Katheria said the families of the victims have been contacted and legal action would be initiated in the case once a complaint is received from them. The police also took the bodies for postmortem.

REPUBLIC DAY



India celebrated its 75th republic day on 26th January 2024 marking the adoption of the constitution on this day in 1950. This year's republic day celebration was graced by the presence of French president Emmanuel Macron as the chief guest. The theme for this year's republic day was "Visit Bharat" and "Bharat Loktantra kMatruka". The theme recognised India's aspirations and its role in strengthening democracy. The celebration as usual started with the PrHident unfurling the national flag followed by the spectacular display of the Republic Day parade at the Kartavya path. This year's parade was a witness to the maiden participation of an all-women's service contingent marching down the Kartavya path. Republic Day is celebrated in India every year on 26th January. This day marks a pivotal movement in Indian history as it monumentalizes the adoption of India's constitution. In 1950 it was on 26 January that India was finally free from the colonial

administration and upheld the value of sovereignty giving India the status of a republic. India gained its independence on 15th August 1947 from the British rule. Following India's independence began the massive task of coming up with an effective constitution to maintain the country's law and order. To that end the constituent assembly was formed to write a constitution for independent India. It was indirectly elected under the cabinet mission plan of 1946. There were 389 members who were part of the assembly however post partition the number came down to 229 as a few members went to Pakistan. Dr Rajendra Prasad was elected as the President of the committee while B.R. Ambedkar was the chairman of the drafting committee. The assembly carried out rigorous debates and discussions for 11 sessions that stretched across 2 years 11 months and 17 days. The final document of the constitution

had 22 parts 395 articles and 8 schedules. The constitution was passed and adopted by the assembly on 26th November 1949. It came into force on 26th January 1950. Dr B.R. Ambedkar is considered the chief architect of the Indian constitution. The Indian constitution is the longest-existing constitution of any sovereign nation in the world providing a comprehensive framework to govern the country with social, cultural and religious diversity. The preamble to the constitution declares India to be a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic, republic and a welfare state committed to securing justice, liberty and equality for the people and for promoting fraternity, dignity of the individual, unity and integrity of the nation. These values are enshrined in the preamble to the constitution which cannot be amended. Till date, 105 amendments have been made to the constitution. The first amendment which happened in 1951 added reasonable restrictions to freedom of speech. Another remarkable

amendment is the 42nd amendment which happened in 1976 included the terms socialist and secular in the preamble and granted more powers to the government during emergencies. The recently updated constitution has 448 articles in 25 parts and 12 schedules. Among the constant conditions and changing dynamics of geopolitics and economic relations of countries with each other, the constitution of India has provided the country with a strong backbone to ensure the well-being of the citizens and a smooth administration. The Indian constitution stands strong as a pillar of a concrete democracy in India.

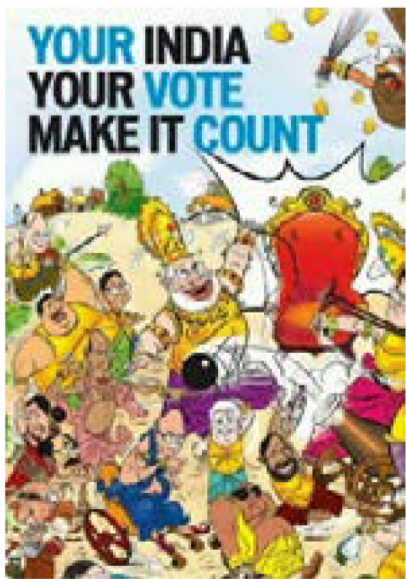

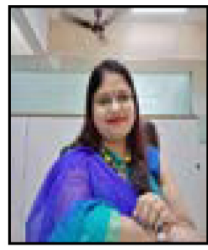

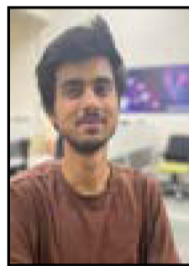

Ram Mandir Inauguration: A Landmark Moment Amidst Controversy and Celebration

Ram Mandir ceremony: The Ram Lalla idol was unveiled at the Pran Pratishtha ceremony attended by PM Modi, RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat and Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath. Here's all that happened amid Ayodhya Ram Temple inauguration.

Last week on Monday 22 January, 2024 marked the historical inauguration of Ayodhya's Ram Mandir which the nation had waited for decades. The occasion is widely seen as a culmination of Hindu majoritarian and political demands led by the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its affiliates. The temple was constructed around the site where the 16th century Babri Mosque stood until a Hindu mob demolished it in 1992. The Supreme Court verdict that handed over the disputed land in Ayodhya to the Hindu



petitioners had also unambiguously noted that the demolition of Babri Masjid on December 6, 1992, by kar sevaks was a "serious violation of law". The long-awaited Pran Pratishtha ceremony of Ram Lalla took place in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, RSS Chief Mohan Bhagwat and several other numbers of VVIPs from whole across the nation. Pran Pratishtha, literally translating to "Establishment of life force," is a Hindu ceremony where an idol of a deity is consecrated and transformed from a mere figure into a vessel of divine energy. Through mantras, offerings, and meticulous rituals, the "Pran," or life force, of the deity is invoked and infused into the idol, rendering it capable of receiving prayers and bestowing blessings upon devotees. This occasion has brought substantial exhilaration and enthusiasm among the people of India and the devotees whole around the world of Lord Rama. Everyone is celebrating the 'Ram Mandir Prana Pratishtha' in their own unique ways. It is so beautiful to see the whole nation cheering and

celebrating over a same cause and the excitement of the homecoming of Ram Lalla isn't bounded within the borders of India. According to Dr Pravin Kendrekar, who lives in South Africa, Hindus living in 52 different countries were approached to connect them emotionally to the cultural and spiritual significance of Ayodhya's momentous event. Prime Minister Narendra Modi led the rituals of Ram Mandir and unveiled the idol of Ram Lalla carved out of black stone and said that Ram Lalla will now stay in a grand temple and not in a tent any more. Addressing the first Mann Ki Baat broadcast of the year, Modi also said that the governance of Lord Ram was a source of inspiration for Constitution makers. He said, "January 22, 2024, is not just a date, but the beginning of a new era. The construction of Ram Mandir has filled people with new energy" and it is not deniable that the whole nation felt an essence of a festival on this occasion keen to Diwali. The grand temple will not just attract pilgrims towards Ayodhya but will also bring a surge in tourism that will create jobs opportunities for both Hindus and Muslims and will ultimately contribute a major part in the town's econ-

omy. But 'every rose has its thorn', on a day before Pran Pratishtha Hindu religious processions in India have turned violent when triumphalism transforms into provocation and violence. While the event passed peacefully, the previous day a group of men in Madhya Pradesh state shouted religious Slogans, climbed atop a Christian church, and affixed a flag representing the new temple to the church's cross. Even though authorities secured the area during the ceremony, Ayodhya's Muslim residents were concerned for their safety due to which Some even sent their families away from the city. Such incidents raises the doubt that whether the establishment of Ram mandir is really a symbol of true faith and hope or people are just hyped because they are convinced that only their religion is supreme over the other's.

However the exceptional limelight on the Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP) will help them to score votes in 2024 Lok sabha elections while on the other hand the opposition will now have to face challenges to fight against such a strong party.

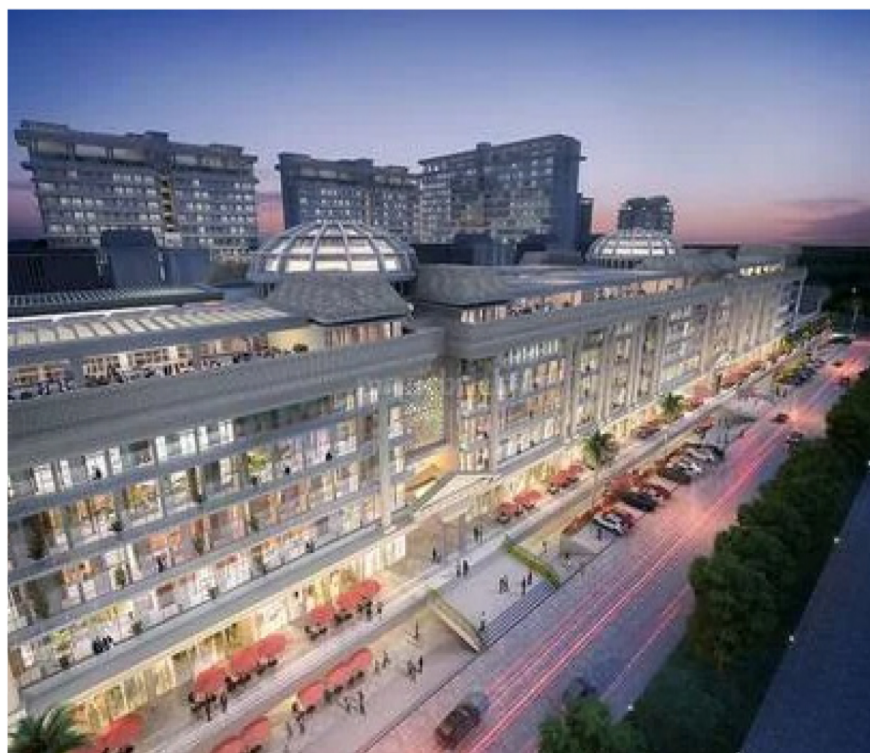
